The district board voted unanimously to offer Brett Antczak, MHA, CMPHE, the top leadership role at St. Vincent Health. The board will enter into contract discussions with Antczak right away, with a goal for him to join the organization in the fourth quarter of 2020.

Antczak's experience in healthcare spans 20 years. He has led clinics, critical access hospitals and large health systems. Having been residents of Colorado in the past, the Antczak's are anxious to return to the Rocky Mountains and become part of the Lake County community. He and his family currently live in Iowa.
